




EASTER TREASURE HUNT

This is a guided treasure hunt that will take place in Singleton Park.
(The answers are at the back!)



Entering Singleton Park from the Gower Road entrance bear left on the path. walking down the path a little way you will see some standing Stones. This looks like a place of sacrifice. Sacrifice is a very important part of the Christian celebration of Easter. As we believe that Jesus was our sacrifice.



1. How many standing Stones surround the Central stone table?

Jesus said that he would give us water, the water he gave would well up inside us and be a power of change to all that we would meet. As you continue on the path.

2. What is powered by water here?



Walk towards the toilet block.



3. How many Park benches can you see from outside the toilet block? And why is this number important in the Christian celebration of Easter?

Continue to the Swiss house. Palm Sunday commemorates the entrance of Christ into Jerusalem, when palm branches were placed in his path, before his arrest on Holy Thursday and his crucifixion on Good Friday.



4. How many palm trees can you count in the grounds of the swift house?

Jesus died on a cross because he loves us and to save us from the wrong things we do.



5. At the entrance of the botanical garden there is a sign it says we cannot do certain things. How many things are we not allowed to do? And what are they?





From here you can see a lake. By the lake there are polls to hold life rings. Life rings are used to save people from drowning. This reminds us that we all need saving.



6. How many poles are around the lake? and what colour are they?



Continue on the path until you get to the signpost. The Christian holiday of Pentecost, which is celebrated the 50th day (the seventh Sunday) from Easter Sunday, commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. As they spoke people could hear them in different languages.



7. According to the sign, what is Mumbles Road exit in Welsh?

Now bear right towards the Italian gardens continue up the path up the hill and down the other side another signpost you will find.

8. At the signpost look to your right What can you see in the wall?



Continue right to the Italian garden past the entrance of the farm depot and you will find the snake-like path at the side of the road, continue along this path.

9. Towards the top of this path you will see a small Cottage what is the roof made of? Also you can see a sign. When do you need to stop and why?



Continue on the path and turn right and in a while, bear right towards the Botanical Gardens. As you walk up the path you will see Sketty Hall. In Jesus day Israel was ruled by Romans look carefully for the next answers



10. How many Roman columns are there?

1. There are 12 standing Stones
2. A Waterwheel
3. There are 3 benches and it was the number of days that Jesus was in the grave
4. There are 7 palm trees
5. There are 5 things: No dogs, No ball games, No bikes, No skates, No skateboards
6. There are two poles which are red/orange
7. Allantfa heol mwbwl
8. It looks like a fire grate or a hole in the wall
9. The roof is made of thatch and you must stop when the light show no because it's a fire station.
10. There are 16 columns
