Its as simple as getting yourself a pot, putting some broken crockery or pots in the bottom for drainage and fill it with some peat free compost mixed with some horticultural grit.

- Crocosmia, gladiolus, lilies and polianthes can all be potted up or planted out, at this time of year.

- In the veg garden now is a perfect time to plant seed potatoes or onion sets - or put peas straight into the ground for a harvest later on!
