First Aid

Sarah Price is the First Aid contact throughout the event. Sarah will be supported by other first aiders, however she will be the main point of contact.


Green Room

The *green room,* aka. the small lounge will be a safe space reserved for those who need a quiet place to go. It will also be the first aid room. No under 18s are allowed in this room unless they are supervised by their accompanying adults.

Lanyards

As a volunteer, you will need to wear a lanyard on the day. This will allow you to access restricted areas (such as the kitchen), and will also enable others to easily identify who can help. Therefore please keep this on whilst you are serving.







Car Park Attendants

- Your role is to ensure those attending are able to park nearby safely and **not** on site.
- For the 5pm service, please arrive by 4pm. For the 7:30pm, please arrive by 6pm.
- You will need to wear a high-vis vest.
- There are no car parking spaces available in the car park unless tickets have been pre-booked. (You will be provided with this list by Sarah Price when you arrive on the day.)
- Anyone who has not booked a car parking space will need to park in the surrounding streets or in the Holy Trinity Church car park. Alternatively, the car park next to Parkland School is also available. Maps will be available to hand out to people on the day should they be needed.

Set up team

- Please help with the setting up of tents, chairs, tables and accessories including lights and kitchen equipment in the outdoor area.
- Please help with the setting up of chairs etc in the main hall and small hall.

Welcoming and Stewarding Team

- What a team! You are the face of Parklands and will be the first point of contact for all those who visit us during the event.
- For the 5pm service, please arrive by 4pm.
- For the 7:30pm, please arrive by 5:50pm.
- For children 11 years of age and younger and in primary school, please ensure parents are offered a wrist band. There is a space for them to write their contact number in case their child becomes lost on site. (Please do not write the child's name on the wristband).
- There are also gift bags for all children under the age of 11 years (and in primary school).

Food team

- Your role is to prepare and/or serve the food during our street food market celebration which will be running from 6pm-7:15pm. Therefore, food will need to be ready for serving by 6pm.
- If you are helping with the food prep, please arrive at 2:30pm.
- Square Peg are serving tea and coffee in the small hall for the duration of the market.
- If you are helping on the pizza team, please arrive by 3:30pm. The pizza oven will need to be fired up by 5pm to ensure it has reached the correct temperature in time.
- If you are helping to serve food, please arrive by 5pm. This will ensure the stations are fully set up and ready to go in time.
- At 7:15pm, please go and enjoy the 7:30pm concert!

Worship and Tech Team

- Thank you so much for serving in our concerts and creating an environment where we can come into the presence of God and worship Him.
- Please liaise with your teams to ensure you arrive with plenty of time to practice, have a run through and check the setup and sound.
- Please wear your lanyard throughout the event particularly when you are off stage, and to enable you to access the 'green room.'





Set down team

- Do not underestimate the important part you play in our team! Your role is to relieve those who have spent all day cooking and serving food!
- Our street food market will close at 7:15pm. Please arrive promptly if you are helping on the kitchen set down team.
- All the condiments, equipment and utensils will need to be cleaned and put away. The kitchen will need to be cleaned and everything put away.
- If you are helping on the set down team with the tents, tables etc please arrive by 7:15pm when the street food market ends.
- Please be mindful of noise etc during this time, as the second concert will be underway.
