Welcoming and Stewarding Team *Led by Boma Kolawole*

- For our 9:15am service, arrive by 8:30am for coffee or 8:45am for prayer and welcoming.
- For our 11:15am service, please arrive by 10:30am for fellowship and welcoming.
- Greet everyone warmly and consider yourself part of the welcoming team throughout the service. Look out for newcomers and those who might be alone.
- Maintain clear walkways and help people to find seats, introduce them to others, and be aware of the fire exits and procedures.
- Assist with offering and communion during the service.

Tea and Coffee Team *No current lead*

- Arrive by 8:40am to make tea and coffee and set up the coffee bar.
- Clean up and put items away after tea and coffee.

Set up and Set down Team *Led by Glyn Davies*

- Arrange the chairs for the service, in line with the chair guide.
- Put chairs away following the service and tidy the hall.
- Set up communion / clear communion away on the relevant Sunday.

Brunch Team *Led by Suzie Bennett*

- Prepare brunch and serve our church family.
- Wash up, clear away and ensure the kitchen is tidy following brunch.

Team principles

- To attend church regularly where possible, not just on days you are serving.
- To demonstrate a Godly wisdom, character and spiritual commitment.
- To be faithful in the small things.
- To be willing to submit your gifts and calling, to serve the leadership and vision of the church.
- To acknowledge this is not a role where you are served, but you are serving the church.
- To commit to developing your gifts, character and approach.
